### Carpark and Parking

Please can I remind parents, who transport their children to school in cars, you should not be pulling up to the school gates and dropping children off or dropping children off on the double yellow lines. This is unsafe and makes it very difficult for children, who are walking to school, to cross the road safely.

Also, I would like to remind parents that they should not be climbing over the small fence around the carpark and walking through the car park to enter school. This is also unsafe. Please walk along the path to enter school.

### Hair Bows

Several girls have started to wear large bows in their hair again. These bows should not be worn to school. Hair bobbles and accessories should be no bigger than, approximately, 5cm.

### Dangerous Litter

Recently parents have, rightly, expressed concern about unsanitary and dangerous litter left near the school's grounds. This has included empty syringes (no needles attached). Please know, staff regularly check the perimeter of school's grounds to make sure the site is safe for children. If parents notice any more dangerous waste please inform school.

### Trim Trail

Several sections of the trim trail on the school field need replacing. These have been cordoned off until work is completed. School's risk assessment for the trim trail states children should not play on the equipment

**before or after school. Please can parents and guardians discourage children from playing on the equipment during this time. This also applies to the equipment in the reception classroom playground.**
