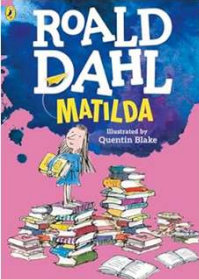
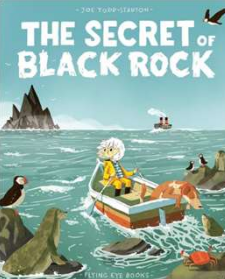
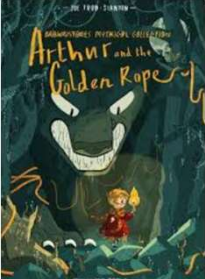




Year 4 Curriculum Map – Autumn 1 2026

- In Writing, we will be writing a recount for the school website based on our visit to Headingley Water Treatment Works. We will also be writing a setting description, and we will prepare a debate based on Halloween. - In Reading, the core text we will be studying is 'Matilda' by Roald Dahl. We will be reading for a range of different purposes, identifying themes in texts and comparing them as well as further investigating the impact of vocabulary used on the reader.	In Geography, we will be studying the water cycle. Using political maps, globes and atlases, we will locate and identify some of the world's major rivers and their formation. We will investigate key aspects of mountain formation and identify mountain features in the UK. In Spanish, the unit we will study is 'presenting myself'. We will build upon the vocabulary we have already learned and focus on asking questions and providing accurate answers.	In Art/DT, we will develop our skills in photography, drawing and collage. This will include developing our understanding of perspective and background/foreground, shading to show shadow and light and overlapping images to create a collage. The artist we will focus on is Megan Coyle. In Cooking, we will be making pancakes and will focus on mixing, stirring, measuring and grating.
