Class information

Clothing

Please ensure that your child attends school wearing a school uniform with black footwear and that all your child's uniform and belongings are labelled clearly with their name. Children need to bring a coat every day. Please leave spare clothing on your child's peg in case of accidents.

PE

PE will start the week beginning 8th October. Please leave a PE kit on their peg labelled with their name. (Shorts, Tshirt and pumps.)

Playdough

We make home made playdough for the children every week and would be grateful for donations of flour, cream of tartar, salt, food colouring and baby wipes. Thank you.

Learning

This half term our theme is Settling in/Ourselves. We will also be finding out from the children what their interests are.

We will begin to learn letter sounds and how to blend them together to read words. We will practise letter formation to write our names, learn number recognition and counting, shape recognition and measures. We will teach the children routines and encourage their developing social skills.

On Thursday 18th October, Reception will be closed for children and we will invite you to come in for a 15 minute meeting to discuss how your child has settled in and how you can support their learning at home.

Helping your child

Phonics and reading

Over the coming weeks we will begin to send home the sounds and tricky words that we have been learning at school. Please work together with your child to learn these. It would be helpful if you could also encourage your child to practise writing their name using the dotted sheets that we will send home.

Your child will be given a reading book to take home after the half term holidays when they are confident with their sounds and understand how to blend them together to read.
