Results

We are extremely proud of this year's SATs results. The children throughout school have worked very hard. In year 6 between 50% and 60% of the children achieved the expected level in reading, writing, grammar or mathematics.

These scores show that the children have made good progress whilst at New Bewerley.

In year 2 over 50% of the children achieved the expected level in reading, writing or mathematics.

68% of the children passed the phonics test in year 1 and 85% passed the phonics test by the end of year 2.

Approx. 50% achieved a Good Level of Development in reception.

All children have received their results and school's data will be published on the website in autumn.

Well done everyone and thank you to the teachers for their amazing efforts.
